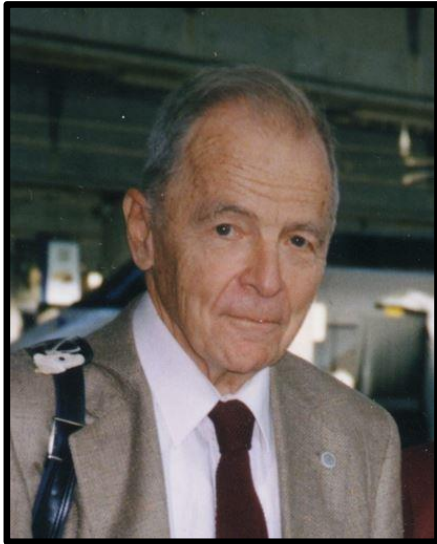


Call for nominations for the Earl W. Stevick Award 2018



[Earl W. Stevick](#) (1923-2013) remains an inspiration to Christian English language teachers through his legacy of creative language teaching, preparation and mentoring of teachers, fruitful scholarship, and exemplary Christian service to the profession.

The Earl W. Stevick Award honors members of the English language teaching profession who embody some of the characteristics of Dr. Stevick in their teaching, mentoring of teachers, scholarship, service to the profession, and living out the life of Christ in this profession.

The winner of the Stevick Award will receive a plaque with an appropriate inscription and a monetary award of \$300. The award will be made at the CELT Conference in **Chicago, 27 March 2018**.

2. responding to any of the following as appropriate: please be specific!

Explain how the nominee has

A. embodied some of the characteristics of Dr. Stevick in living out the life of Christ in this profession (See the [two articles about Dr. Stevick in the CELEA Newsletter of October 2014](#).)

B. engaged in the kind activities that Dr. Stevick valued, including

- mentoring of teachers (provide stories of support)
- engaging in scholarship (describe the scholarly productions)
- serving the profession (describe the service) and
- doing lay ministry behind the scenes (provide examples)

Nominations are due 19 January, 2018.
